## II. APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT

 Downtown Grand Junction Business Improvement District/Grand Junction Downtown Partnership, 248 S. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – Wells Fargo Art & Jazz Festival, May 9<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup>, Main Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Grand Junction

Diane Keliher and George Rossman were present.

City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Kemp, for the record, if a letter was provided by the applicant stating no licensed facilities were available or adequate. Ms. Kemp confirmed that the applicant had provided a letter.

City Attorney Shaver said in reference to 12-48-103, C.R.S. regarding that existing licensed facilities are unavailable or inadequate for the purpose of serving members or guests of the organization and that additional facilities are necessary by reason of the nature of the special event, the statute has been complied with, and he recommended approval.

Hearing Officer Grattan agreed and approved the application for a special events permit.
