AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCES NO. 426, 443, 455, AND 457, ENTITLED "ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, that Section 1 of Ordinance No. 426, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Salaries", passed and adopted the 21st day of December, A. D. 1927; Ordinance No. 443, passed and adopted December 19th, 1928; Ordinance No. 455, passed and adopted December 4th, 1929; and Ordinance No. 457, passed and adopted January 2nd, 1930, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
