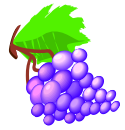

Legislation Concerning Alcoholic Beverages

SB 93 – Defines a responsible alcohol beverage vendor as a vendor that successfully completes a seller/server training program authorized by the director of liquor enforcement in the Department of Revenue and specifies that the director shall set training standards for such programs. It directs state and local licensing authorities to consider such training as a mitigating factor when determining penalties against a licensee for a sale to minor occurring as part of an underage compliance check. This bill has been signed by the Governor and becomes effective July 1, 2004.

SB 44 – Authorizes the owner of a retail gaming tavern to own an interest in a hotel and restaurant licensed establishment. This bill has been signed by the Governor and becomes effective August 4, 2004.

HB 1021 – Reduces from 0.10 to 0.08 the level of blood alcohol content for the offense of driving under the influence, thus making the state entitled to

additional federal transportation funds. Also authorizes on premise "tastings" events at licensed retail facilities at local government option and a hotel and restaurant licensee to allow removal from the licensed premises of an opened unfinished (re-corked) 750 milliliter bottle of vinous liquor. This bill has been signed by the Governor and becomes effective July 1, 2004.

HB 1357 - Creates a "vintner's restaurant license" that parallels the brew pub license. Instead of beer, though, local wine manufacturers open a restaurant at which their product is sold for consumption or carry-out, and other malt, vinous, or spirituous liquor may be sold for on-premise consumption. This bill has been signed by the Governor and becomes effective August 4, 2004.
