
The discharge permit issued to your facility was granted an administrative extension prior to expiration of this permit on 6/30/83. We find it necessary at this time to grant another administrative extension of this permit.

The Water Quality Control Division is in the process of issuing you a new permit, but the review procedures required by law have not been completed. Accordingly, we are giving you notice by this letter that your previous permit is reissued as a temporary permit pursuant to Section 6.10.1 (1) of the Regulations for the State Discharge Permit System. This temporary permit shall expire on the effective date of your new permit, or one (1) year from the date of this letter, whichever occurs earlier.

All effluent limitations, monitoring requirements, and other permit terms and conditions will remain in effect until that time.

Please find enclosed a copy of the public notice extending your permit.

ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY CDPS PERMITS

Purpose of Public Notice:

The purpose of this notice is to state the intention of the Colorado Department of Health, Water Quality Control Division, to issue temporary permits for the below listed permittees pending completion of review procedures required prior to renewal of the permits. See Section 6.10.1 of the Regulations for the State Discharge Permit System. Permit conditions will be those of the permits that expired June 30, 1983. This temporary permit will expire upon the effective date of the permanent permit but in no event later than 2 years or until a final determination is made to issue or deny the final permit.
