Mr. R. J. Mandeville, president of Western Engineers, was kind enough to send me a copy of a letter which he wrote to you on December 28, 1972. This letter concerns future planning of waste treatment in the Grand Valley. I concur 100% with Mr. Mandeville's statements. In fact, I wish Mr. Mandeville had enlarged on his statements a little more, especially concerning plant location.

The lift station, located at the west end of the Grand Avenue Bridge, was designed to handle the effluent from the packing plant. The writer worked with Morcan Engineering of Delta on this project. We allowed for a margin of overload, but the lift station would not be large enough to accommodate a shopping center. Munro Supply, Inc. eventually sold all of the components of that particular job with the exception of the steel pipe under the bridge. Therefore, I am quite familiar with that immediate problem, as well as the other problems Mr. Mandeville mentions in his letter.

A representative of the Ute Chapter of Professional Engineers would be glad to discuss these problems with you, if you would care to avail yourselves of this service.
