PROPOSED PRIORITY POINTS FOR EPA GRANTS

February 19, 1974

The priority point system will be used by the State Water Quality Control Commission in reviewing applications for EPA grants. The State and EPA priority systems give highest priority to wastewater treatment works and a secondary priority is given to interceptor sewers. In the event there are more EPA funds than can be used for wastewater treatment works, the same point system will be used in reviewing applications for interceptor sewers which serve areas already eighty percent developed prior to October 1, 1972 in accordance with the 1972 EPA Act. Collection lines and interceptors serving areas not 80 percent developed prior to October 1, 1972 are not eligible for EPA grants.

The State priority system requires submittal of plans and specifications, feasibility report, environmental impact assessment, infiltration/inflow analyses, planning agencies clearance, etc., with the application. In the event a qualified entity does not proceed with engineering, planning, and local financing and submit a completed application package for the review by the Commission, the Commission will move down the priority list to the next entity which has completed all the requirements for being considered for a grant.

Funds will not be held for any entity just because they are high on the priority point list.
