Attached are some notes from EPA concerning Grand Junction Ordinance 1536, dealing with City Code Chapter 25 "Sewer Ordinances". We must amend our ordinances to comply in order to receive additional EPA grants.

Also attached, is a model ordinance, dealing with industrial cost recovery charges. We don't have an industry contributing a large enough percentage of total flow for this to apply to us at this time, but we still need the ordinance.

Last, attached is a model ordinance for equitable service charges. Maybe ours could be amended to give our present rates, with a clause stating that they will be reviewed annually and adjusted if necessary, to assure that they are equitable as defined in Section 3 and 4 of the model ordinance.

We need to submit a timetable for compliance right away. We have several months to make the actual changes, but we need to give them a written timetable for making these changes. This time table needs to be attached to our grant applications which we will have to submit before September 23, 1976.
