Dear Mr. May:

We are in receipt of your certified letter of February 24, 1978, regarding delinquent self-monitoring report, NPDES Number: CO-0028835, Mesa County.

The Grand Junction "201" Facilities Plan has identified several existing "package" sewage treatment plants that can be taken out of service by the coordinated construction of interceptor lines and a new regional wastewater treatment plant.

A portion of the plan that has already been constructed is the Paradise Hills Interceptor. Sewage that was previously treated at the Paradise Hills package plant operating under NPDES permit number CO-0028835, Mesa County, is now being diverted through the Paradise Hills Interceptor for treatment at the City of Grand Junction sewage treatment plant. The Paradise Hills package plant is no longer in operation.

Discharge Permit Number CO-0028835, Mesa County, can now be cancelled or voided. If there is a procedure of form for doing this, I will be happy to comply if you will let me know what that procedure is. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
