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We request this Step 3 grant application be placed on the September 1979 WQCC Agenda in anticipation of Step 3 bidding and construction on this project later this fall and extending into the calendar year 1980. This sewer is necessary for both the permanent 12.5 mgd WWTP presently under design and can be effectively utilized in conjunction with a 1.0 mgd temporary plant (flow equalization basins utilized as aerated lagoons until the permanent plant is completed) now being evaluated in conjunction with your staff and EPA.
