The Grand Junction City Council at its regular meeting on Dec. 17, 1980 passed for publication an Ordinance which will increase the monthly sanitary sewer service fee beginning with the first billing in February 1981. The Mesa County Board of Commissioners approved this rate increase on Dec. 9, 1980. The rate structure approved was the proposed rate structure of which I had sent you a copy of earlier.

As per your letter of Dec. 17, 1980, it is our understanding that the District will provide maintenance for the system in 1981. As a result the rate per EQU. for District users will be reduced to \$3.95 to allow credit for replacement costs and for maintenance done by the District.

To avoid the City having to make two rate changes, it is our request to continue to provide maintenance service and continue our current charges through the month of January 1981. If this is not agreeable please let us know and we will try to work out something for the month of January.
