Dear Miss Kinder:

Pursuant to your request of the week of February 1, 1982, please accept this letter in response to your question regarding fees remitted to the City for services rendered.

Central Grand Valley Sewer District remitted to the City the sum of \$174,053.00 for 1981. Of this money, approximately \$13,750.00 went toward flushing and rodding, which is equal to 235.45 hours (at 58.40 cents per hour). The District had 17,323 feet of sewer line rodded. This is equivalent to 434 hours of two men and two to three pieces of machinery which equates to \$25,344.12 in cost. Above and beyond these costs, the City also responded to 21 emergency calls.

In addition to the flushing and rodding, \$13,924.24 went toward administration and billing, \$106,525.93 toward collection and treatment of Grand Valley sewage and finally, \$39,852.83 toward the retirement of the debt for the old treatment plant. This totals \$174,053.00 in remitted fees.
