Dear Edith:

In an effort to align our budget areas, property and improve efficiency of our field sewer maintenance crews, I have shifted their budget and their supervision over to the Waste Water Treatment Plant Operations.

This move will help both the maintenance section and our plant operators through better coordination of activities, now and in the future, as we are starting into many new projects - a new valley wide plant, new sewer mains and interceptors and an improved system of waste water treatment.

The improved (activated sludge) process does require that we have a pre-treatment program in the collection systems and better trained people in both collection systems as well as plant operators. (What happens in the field effects the plant's capability to perform as it should).

It is for these reasons, along with the fact that the plant and systems are County owned and City operated, that I want the people and their respective budgets working under the same supervision area.
