BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS POSITION CONCERNING THE
1984 RATE STRUCTURE FOR THE PERSIGO WASH
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATION AND
ORDERLY SYSTEM EXPANSION

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Mesa County Board of Commissioners to have this service provided in a manner that does not require a subsidy from the County General Fund; and

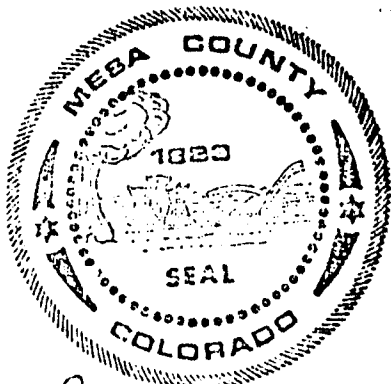
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledge that the initial operation of this plant will promote costs that could exceed the revenues anticipated in the 1984 rate projections; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to initiate a system within the Persigo Wash Wastewater Treatment Plant service area that allows for the timely and orderly growth of the system necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Mesa, Colorado, as follows:

The Commissioners wish to promote the timely and orderly connection of residential, commercial and industrial facilities within the Persigo Wash Wastewater Treatment Plant's service area based on a user fee level that prevents the necessity of subsidizing the operation through use of the County General Fund.
