SUBJ: City County Relationships

The following is a list of current relationships between the County and the City of Grand Junction, and my understanding of the status of each:

1) Data Processing - currently under review, RFP for consulting services being prepared; no written City/County contract; cost allocation should be reviewed. Should have interim agreement covering cost allocation, steering committee, etc. until longer term questions are settled.

2) <u>Printing</u> - City Print Shop occupies County building; County uses services on job basis and pays for each; no written agreement, no charge for building space; space charge should be discussed; County also buys services outside and does considerable printing in house (eg Tri-River Extension)

3) <u>Graphics</u> - County division with services available to City by the job.

4) <u>Animal Control</u> - Written agreement effective 2/1/84 for County to provide services to City; has worked well but contract and cost requires annual review (now underway).

5) <u>Building Department</u> - County employees furnish services to City with no written agreement; County will make proposal to City on agreement for 1985, should be given top priority.

6) <u>Planning</u> - Separate departments sharing space in County building; no building space charges currently, has been proposed for 1985. Shared space allows coordination of efforts, shared files, etc.

7) <u>M.P.O.</u> - County provides staff support for joint transportation planning effort. Agreements in place and routinely maintained.

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8) <u>Sewer</u> <u>System</u> - Persigo Plant and

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unincorproated collection systems owned by County, operated by City; current agreement should be reviewed as it was understood (by County) to be interim agreement. New agreement will be major project. We'd like to get started on discussions soon.

9) <u>Telephone</u> System - Located in Courthouse; unclear shared responsibility for staffing and management; currently under review by County; verbal assurances originally given of City assistance in staffing switchboard but no help currently given.

10) Orchard Mesa Pool - District 51 - City -County relationship, City operated with 50% of deficit charged to County; we would like larger voice in operating decisions or "out".

11) <u>Property</u> <u>Ownership</u> - Joint ownership of Powers property (F Road adjacent to County's Cross Orchards' property) and Berry-Brice property (adjacent to Appleton School); we suggest clarifying ownership by one entity only; County has no resources to assist development. Powers property is rented back to original owners who use it as their own - this should be reviewed.

12) <u>Traffic Signal Maintenance</u> - County work is done under contract by City.

Potential areas for discussing mutually beneficial relations include the following: a) mailroom b) purchasing c) fleet maintenance d) traffic sign fabrication (agreement being negotiated) e) traffic operations and pavement markings f) long term building space g) parks maintenance h) street sweeping i) cable t.v. local access channel j) surveying and mapping k) design engineering (by job) l) safety program m) records management/microfilming n) janitorial, grounds maintenance, building maintenance o) training p) investment counselor q) others
