A letter from Greg Trainor addressing my concerns as to the status of Banner's report, a list of prioritized sewer collection line projects, and the start date for this work is again vague and incomplete.

Greg'states in the letter that Banner is working on the feasibility reports on 26 locations throughout the County that will provide us with a listing of possible projects where sewer collection lines can be extended. Banner is about 50% complete with its work.

According to Greg, for more information I should ask Marce or Bennett, because they attended the meeting with Banner and they can provide me with the additional information I desire.

Greg asked me to provide him with a status report that outlines the County's effort to create Local Improvement Districts in areas that require sewer services.

It is this kind of altitude and slow progress that leads me to think that the quicker we settle the County-City Persigo relationship the sooner we can deal with the Persigo Plant and the sewer collection lines.

I will be conferring with Marce and Bennett on the LID situation before I get back to Greg on the County's position on LID's.
