Greg states in the letter that Banner is working on the feasibility reports on 26 locations throughout the County that will provide us with a listing of possible projects where sewer collection lines can be extended. Banner is about 50% complete with its work.

According to Greg, for more information I should ask Marce or Bennett, because they attended the meeting with Banner and they can provide me with the additional information I desire.

Greg asked me to provide him with a status report that outlines the County's effort to create Local Improvement Districts in areas that require sewer services.

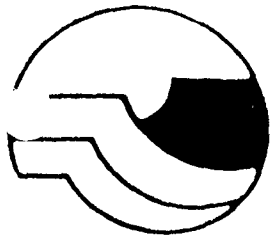
