We met to discuss the proposed Orchard Mesa Sanitation Districts sewer line route to serve Valle Vista subdivision. Mike reviewed the proposed plans as prepared by Westwater Engineering on January 28 and physically inspected the sewer line route on January 31.

Keith Rose's comments regarding the proposed sewer included:

- 1. No endangered species other than possible migratory would be affected by the proposed project.
- 2. No specialized habitat that endangered species might require would be affected by the proposed project.

- 1. This project would have no impacts to wetalands of major significance.
- 2. This project will not have any impacts on endangered, threatened, or canidate species.
