Subject: Trip to Denver

On Tuesday, December 6, 1977, several members traveled to Denver to meet with the Water Quality Control Commission concerning the wastewater treatment plant. The presentation of various alternatives and the revised pre-design study was presented to the Water Quality Control Commission, addressing land application. The Commission decided to delay their decision until their January meeting.

The trip was made to Denver on United Airlines and return by Frontier Airlines. Those who attended the Commission hearing were the Mayor of the City of Grand Junction, Larry Kozicek; Jim Patterson, Public Works Director, City of Grand Junction; and Howard Roland of Mesa County Commission.
