The City of Grand Junction, Colorado would like to request permits from the Colorado Highway Department to open cut underneath I-70 at River Road, to bore across U. S. Highway 6 & 50 at 24<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Road and across U. S. Highway 6 & 50 at Independent Ave. and perform construction within the Highway Rights-of-Way.

Transmitted with this letter are 5 prints of Sheets 1 & 2 Independent Ave. Interceptor Sewer, Sheets 22 & 23 Paradise Hills Interceptor Sewer and Sheet 4 with a detail sheet of the River Road Interceptor Sewer. These sheets illustrate the proposed construction of an 18", 24" and 54" Interceptor Sewer.

This project has not yet been bid, but the anticipated construction will begin sometime in the Summer of 1978. The permits should be made out to the City of Grand Junction, City Hall, Grand Junction, Colorado 81501.
