

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One story with front gable. Entrance is from the side. Wrought iron railing along sidewalk, steps and stoop. Concrete steps and stoop lead to screened porch with dropped gable extending across south half of facade. Windows are double hung, wood sash, four and five vertical light over one. White asbestos shingle siding. All trim is white. Gray composition shingle roof with knee braces under eaves and bargeboards. Brick chimney on north slope. Landscaped with lawn, large barberry bushes along porch facade. Woodbine on porch south elevation. High hedge along lawn frontage on 1st Street and along north side of driveway. Gas lantern on black steel post at end of railing near driveway.
