The occupants are unknown between 1907-1921, but the owners were W. S. and Martha Green. Edward Parsons, a laborer, was the owner and occupant ca. 1921-1927. The house was vacant from 1929-1930. J. Grant Sawyer, a railroader, and Verdie Sawyer owned and resided in the house, ca. 1930-1946.


