

Squared full height columns on front corners. Screen door. Paneled front door. Corner boards and columns on porch have capitals. Windows are double hung wood sash, one-over-one. White simple drop siding. Windows and door surrounds and cornice are pale yellow. Light gray composition shingle roof with brick chimney on roof deck.


