ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One story with hip roof and cross gables. Battered foundation. Concrete steps, framed by wood shingled piers, lead to screened porch with gable roof in center of facade. Battered half-wall covered with wood shingles. Squared half posts are doubled in the corners. Metal screen door. Main door is paneled with three lights of beveled glass. Two sets of French windows flank the main door. Concrete steps lead to smaller enclosed sunporch with gable roof on north elevation. Wood shingled half-wall with squared half posts doubled at corners. Porch is glazed with double hung sash, twelve over one. Paneled porch door with light divided into twelve panes. Double hung wood sash windows, fifteen over one, around the house. Wood shingle slding up to the window sills painted brown. Upper wall has narrow lapped clapboards painted white. Wood shingles painted white appear in both gables. Windows frames painted black. Exposed rafter ends and knee braces and bargeboards in porches painted white. Fascia, corner boards and window surrounds are white. Brown composition shingle flared roof with overhanging eave. Brick chimney on north slope.
