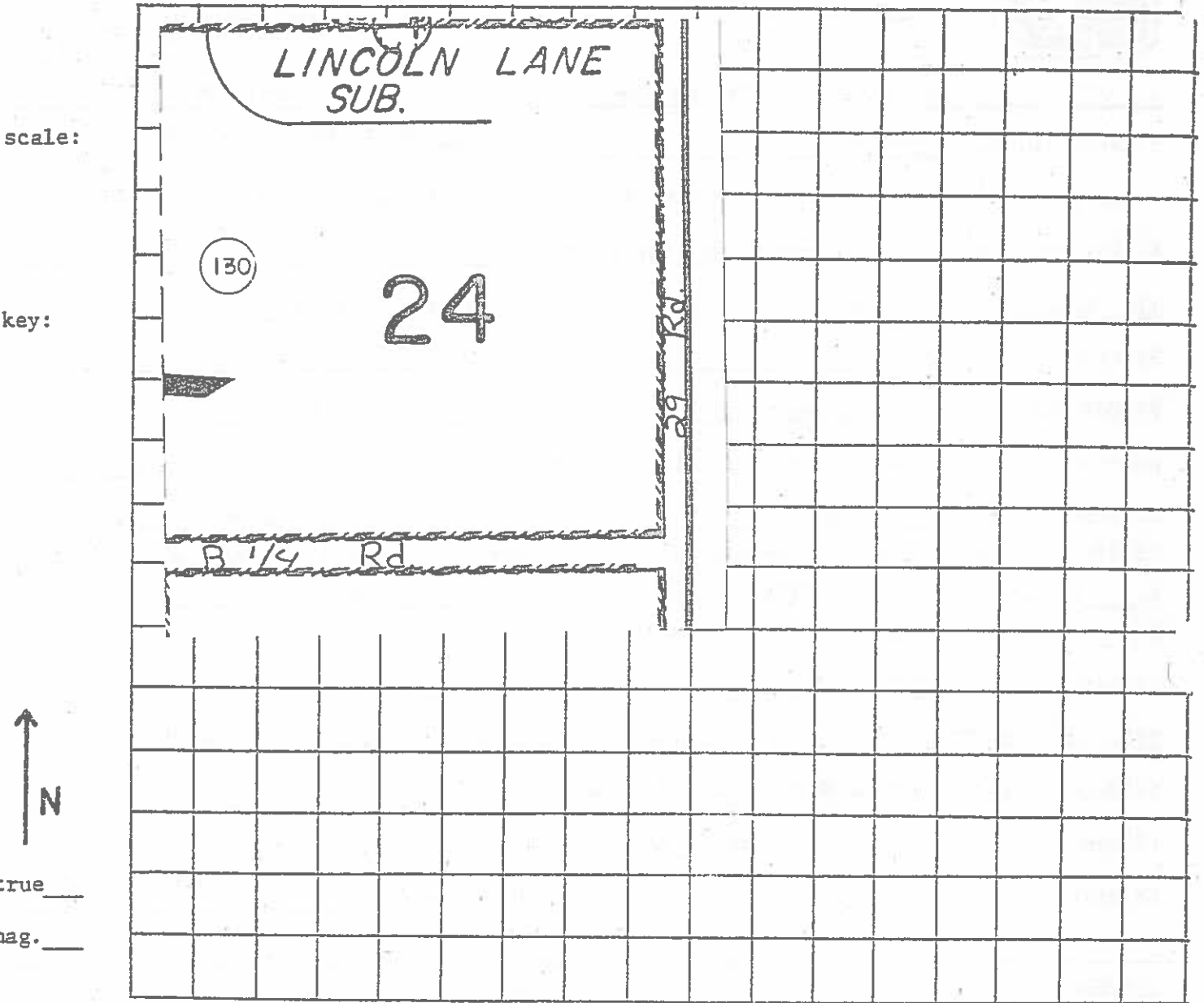

This simple German-Russian style house was modified by its owners with the addition of a dormer and a porch with doric columns to give it a classical revival look.

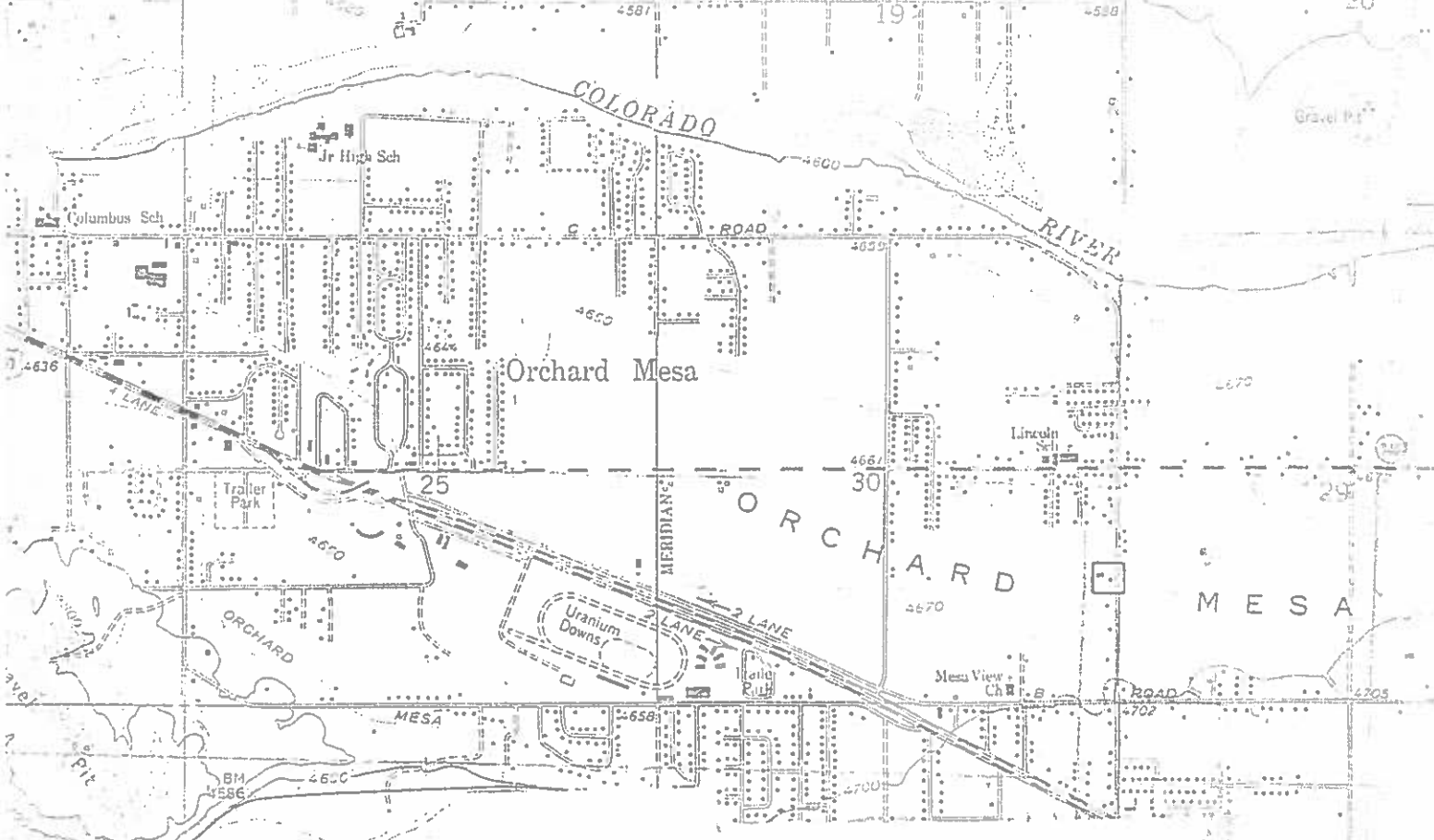
This house is significant as an interesting and unusual early alteration of the classic German-Russian style.
