

This ranch style house is one of the earlier extant, intact rural farm houses. The porch, apparently added after its initial construction, is influenced by a simplified classical look in the columns and a modified western stick style in the design on the front porch half-wall. The structure is largely intact and is part of a complex of structures associated with rural life.
