Allison is working on holiday advertising. Absolute Prestige will be offering free carriage rides in the downtown area after Thanksgiving. This will be a \$1,200 savings for the BID. The BID is still looking for one more sponsor for the Parade of Lights.

October is CMU Mav month downtown. Many businesses are offering discounts and food specials to Mav students, parents and alumni.

Allison prepared a Downtown Infographic which will help explain the BID and DDA roles. This information will be helpful and available to the public. The graphic designer needs to make a few changes and then it will be available.

The next BID meeting will be November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
