

ORDINANCE NO. 627

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE WIDTH OF THE ROADWAY ON NORTH AVENUE
BETWEEN FIRST STREET AND TWELFTH STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND
JUNCTION:

SECTION 1. That on North Avenue, between First Street and
Twelfth Street, in said City, the roadway shall be fifty-six feet
in width, and the curb line shall be twelve feet distant from the
property line.
