Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Holly Lane from Unawep Avenue to the end of the road was conducted on June 8, 2000. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Article IV, Sections 4-2 and 4-3 of the 1977 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-10 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Holly Lane from Unawep Avenue south to the end of the roadway will be posted 25 M.P.H.
