Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Hermosa Avenue from 12th St to 15th St was conducted on July 18, 2000. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Article IV, Sections 4-2 and 4-3 of the 1977 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-10 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Hermosa Avenue is a residential street without a posted speed limit.

Speed Regulation:

Post Hermosa Avenue, from 12th St to 15th St, with 25 mph speed limit signs.
