Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Laura Lee Ave & Sunshine Lane from 27.5 Rd to B.5 Rd was conducted on March 15, 2001. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Article IV, Sections 4-2 and 4-3 of the 1977 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-10 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Residential area. Street classification is local. Street has no curb, gutter or sidewalks. No Mechanical speed study required. Sunshine Lane is posted 30mph, Laura Lee Avenue has no posted speed limit. Findings are on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

The existing 30 mph posted speed limit on Sunshine Lane shall be reduced to 25 mph. Laura Lee Avenue shall have a posted speed limit of 25 mph.
