Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Standing Rock Drive from South Camp to subdivisoin interior was conducted on March 16, 2001. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Article IV, Sections 4-2 and 4-3 of the 1977 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-10 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Residential area. Street classification is local. Street is one of three entrances into a subdivision. The other two streets are posted at 25 mph. Findings are on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

The speed limit on Standing Rock Drive shall be posted at 25 mph.
