Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of 19<sup>th</sup> Street from Orchard Ave. to Walnut Ave. was conducted on August 20, 2002. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

During the field investigation for traffic calming request, it was documented that the speed limit postings on 19th St. Orchard Avenue. to Bookcliff Avenue are inconsistent (20 mph, Orchard to Walnut & 15 mph, Walnut to Bookcliff). Both these sections of 19th Street function primarily as alley accesses. A work order will be issued to lower the speed limit to 15 mph. on 19th St. Orchard Avenue to Walnut Avenue. Speed Regulation:

Existing speed limit of 20 m.p.h. on 19<sup>th</sup> Street from Orchard Ave to Walnut Ave. will be lowered to 15 m.p.h.
