Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of 5th Street from Grand Ave. to North Ave was conducted on November 26, 2002. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Speed Zone Study is on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

The speed limit on 5th Street, Grand Ave. to North Ave. shall be reduced from 35 MPH to 30 MPH.

This is a temporary reduction for the duration of the lane reduction for the 5th St. traffic calming study area (approximately 2 months)
