Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Lilac Ln from Ella St. to Lorey Dr. to include Overlook Dr. & Poplar Ave. was conducted on May 20, 2003. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed taken. Lilac Ln. is a local street in a residential neighborhood with no sidewalks and back out driveways. Lilac lane connects to Lorey Dr. by way of Overlook Dr. The roadway widths fluctuate through, from 18ft. to 24ft. with a 90 degree turn onto Overlook Dr. and a hill on Lorey Dr. approaching Ella St. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Existing WB 30 MPH speed limit on Lilac Lane shall be changed to 20 MPH. Lorey Drive, Ella St. to Overlook Drive shall be posted 20 MPH. To include connecting streets Overlook Dr. & Poplar Dr.
