Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of S. Rim Drive from 23 Road to S. Teal Court and 23 Rd. North of S. Rim Drive was conducted on July 1, 2003. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed taken. Section of S. Rim Dr. that is currently posted 30 MPH is less than 1000 ft. Need to change to 25 MPH as the rest of S. Rim Dr. east of 23 Rd. 23 Rd. North of S. Rim Drive is a residential area. 24 ft. wide street has no curb gutter, or sidewalk. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

South Rim Dr. from 23 Road to S. Teal Ct. shall be posted 25 MPH.

23 Road north of South Rim Dr. shall be posted 25 MPH. Posting shall apply to all ajoining streets off of 23 Road north of South Rim Drive.
