Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of 24 3/4 Road from G Rd. to Roaring Fork Rd. was conducted on August 5, 2003. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Speed Zone Study is on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

24 3/4 Rd. G Road to Roaring Fork Road speed limit shall be raised from 20 MPH to 25 MPH. All adjoining roads shall fall under the 25 MPH posting.
