Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of EW Alley from 4th St. to 5th St and Colorado Ave. to Main St. was conducted on March 18, 2004. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Speed Regulation:

The East West Alley located between 4th Street & 5th Street and Colorado Avenue & Main Street shall be posted 15 MPH.
