Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Teller Avenue from 28 1/2 Road to the end of Teller Avenue was conducted on July 16, 2004. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data collected. Teller Avenue is a local residential dead end roadway. No curb, gutter, or sidewalk. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Teller Avenue from 28 1/2 Rd. to the end of roadway shall be posted 20 MPH.
