Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the Colorado West Development Park Area was conducted on July 20, 2004. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data collected. The Colorado West Development Park Area is an industrial area with 44' wide streets. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

All listed streets in the Colorado West Development Park Area shall have a speed limit of 25 MPH. to include 4th Ave.

- Winters Ave. between 10th St. & S. 15th St.
- S. 12th St. Between D Rd. & Winters Ave.
- S. 15th St. Between D Rd. & Winters Ave.
- Kimball Ave. Between 9th St.& S. 12th St.
