Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Sherman Dr. and Fischer Ave. from B 1/2 Rd. to the end of the roadways was conducted on November 16, 2004. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-11 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2000 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data collected. Roadways are local residential with commercial properties. No curb gutter or sidewalk. 24 ft. wide roadway with curvature.

Speed Regulation:

Sherman Dr. & Fishcher Ave shall be posted 20 MPH from B 1/2 Rd. to the end of the roadways.
