Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Spanish Trail Dr. from G Rd. to Jack Creek Rd. and Jack Creek Rd., 24 1/2 Rd. to Willow Creek Rd. was conducted on May 9, 2005. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed recorded. Area is local residential street with curb gutter & sidewalk. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Spanish Trail Dr. North of G Rd. shall be posted 20 MPH and Jack Creek Rd. west of 24 1/2 Rd. Shall be posted 20 MPH. All connecting streets within Spanish Trail Subdivision shall fall under the 20 MPH speed limit.
