Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Ridges Blvd from School Ridge Rd. to Meridian Ct to include all connecting streets in between was conducted on November 14, 2005. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No Mechanical speed data gathered. This section of Ridges Blvd. is in the Redlands Mesa Golf Course area and has golf cart crossing throughout. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Ridges Blvd. from School Ridge Rd. to Meridian Ct. and including all connecting streets in between shall be posted 25 MPH. .
