Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Industrial Blvd. from 24 1/2 Rd. to 25 Rd. was conducted on December 27, 2005. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed taken. Area is industrial, no curb gutter or sidewalk. Prima facie speed for this area is 25 mph. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Industrial Blvd. from 24 1/2 Rd. to 25 Rd. shall be posted 25 MPH.
