Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Village Park Dr. from 25 1/2 Rd. to 25 1/2 Rd. was conducted on December 29, 2005. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Roadway is local residential and has two 90 degree curves. Curb gutter & sidewalk. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Village Park Dr. shall be posted 20 MPH. from 25 1/2 Rd. back to 25 1/2 Rd.
