Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Sherman Dr. from 27 Rd. to B1/2 Rd. and Dorothy Ave. from SH 50 to Sherman Dr. was conducted on March 16, 2006. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed study conducted. Connecting streets are already posted 20 MPH. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Sherman Dr. from 27 Rd. to B 1/2 Rd. shall be posted 20 MPH. The existing speed limit of 30 MPH on Dorothy Ave. shall be reduced to 20 MPH.
