Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Fall Creek Dr from Unaweep Avenue to Snyder Creek Dr was conducted on May 3, 2007. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical Speed study conducted. Roadway is a local residential no outlet with curb gutter & sidewalk. Roadway shall be posted as similar streets in the area.

Speed Regulation:

Fall Creek Dr. shall all be posted 25 MPH between Unaweep Ave. & Snyder Creek Dr. All conecting streets to include Snyder Creek Dr. Arrasta Ct., Arrasta Ln., & Grizzly Ct. shall fall under the posted speed limit on Fall Creek Dr.
