Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Wellington Avenue from N.7th Street to N.11th Street was conducted on July 26, 2007. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Roadway operates as a minor collector and is surrounded by medical facilities and business offices. Prima facie speed limit for this type of roadway is 25 MPH and shall be posted as such.

Wellington Avenue between N.7th St. & N.11th St. shall be posted 25 MPH.
