Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of 7th Street from Ute Ave to Grand Ave. was conducted on December 13, 2007. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

The current posting on the above street segment is 30 MPH. The roadway has been narrowed and medians installed along with on street back in parking. This a a business district and the Colorado prima facie speed limits for business districts is 25 MPH. Speed Regulation:

The speed limit on 7th Street between Ute Ave. & Grand Ave. shall be reduced to 25 MPH.
