Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Belhaven Way from Patterson Road to Cascade Avenue was conducted on March 28, 2008. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical Speed study conducted. Roadway is a local residential, with curb gutter & sidewalk that connects to Cascade Ave. which is connected to W Indian Creek Dr. which is posted 25 MPH.

Belhaven Way shall be posted 25 MPH between Patterson Rd. & Cascade Way.
