Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Larkspur Lane-Dahlia Drive-Crestridge Drive from 26 1/2 Road to G Road and including all connecting street was conducted on August 1, 2008. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data. Streets are local residential 22 ft. wide with no curb gutter or sidewalk. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Larkspur Lane-Dahlia Drive-Crestridge Drive shall be posted 20 MPH from 26 1/2 Rd. to G Rd. Posting shall also apply to all connecting streets; Step-a-side Dr., Larkspure Ct. & Hollyhock Ln.
